**ROSENDAHL STATEMENT ON PROPOSED
WIDENING OF SEPULVEDA BOULEVARD**

Councilman Bill Rosendahl today issued the following statement in regards to the proposed widening of Sepulveda Boulevard in Westchester:

"After thorough review and study of the issue, I do not support going forward with the widening of Sepulveda Boulevard, between 74th Street and Howard Hughes Parkway.

In July, I held a public meeting to listen to proponents and opponents of the widening project and also met with the Los Angeles Department of Transportation. Due to the overwhelming response of Westchester residents opposed to the project, I have made a decision to support the wants and needs of the Westchester community.

Although the proposed widening does have its merits, it does not prove to be substantially beneficial for the neighborhoods affected by the project. The community has spoken loudly and clearly regarding their objection to the project and I support them in this opposition.

I would like to thank all community stakeholders, especially the Westchester Neighborhood Council, Westchester Vitalization Corporation, Westchester Streetscape Improvement Association and Westchester residents for the valuable input given to resolve this matter."
